

# Get to Know...

## WHITEHALL Goodwill Store

### Where?

The Whitehall store is located at 2780-90 Saw Mill Run Boulevard (Route 51), 3 miles from the Liberty Tunnel.

### When?

The store originally opened in the mid 1980's and it was expanded in 1994-95, adding the large processing/donation center. The Whitehall store is 10,584 square feet with a 5,000 square foot processing/donation center. The hours are Monday through Saturday, 9:00am-8:00pm and Sunday, 11:00am-5:00pm.

### Who?

Whitehall has three supervisors, Diane Druker, Team Leader; Sharon Angel, Assistant Manager; and Irene Schrecengost, Manager. There are currently one full-time and eight part-time employees, along with a partnership group of five supported employees and four clients coached by Angela Engram.

### Donations?

The donations are received at the processing/donation center next to the store. Whitehall averages about 450-600 donors per week. The donors come from the many surrounding neighborhoods and the donors are generous in giving their goods.

### Interesting Facts:

The Whitehall Store was the first Goodwill store in Pittsburgh to have a partnership group. This partnership began in 1995. The first job coach was Suzanne Ratnavale, now the Director of Disability Services, and she was followed by Janice Hylton, Supervisor-Partnership.
