Bag or Box Your Donations

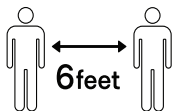
Bring your donations in bags or boxes - no loose donations, please!

Safe Social Distancing

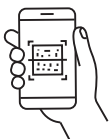
Please stay 6 feet away from Goodwill employees and other donors.
